

Residential Life COVID-19 Health and Wellbeing Commitment

In the era of COVID-19, a collective commitment to the health and wellbeing of each other has never been more essential, especially in an on-campus residential living environment. Housing and Residence Life at Virginia Tech is a powerful experience that will nurture friendships, facilitate learning, and introduce you new ideas, experiences and people. Protecting you, your neighbors, and this experience will require the full attention and daily dedication of every resident.

It is for this reason that students who will live in Virginia Tech residence halls are required to sign and abide by this agreement.

The Commitments:

- 1. To the best of my ability, I will engage in a 14-day quarantine before arriving.
- 2. Consistent with the Governor's directive, aligning with University protocol and standards, I will wear a face mask at all times while in my residence hall (except when in my own room, the bathroom, or eating a meal) unless I have a recognized medical condition.
- 3. I will practice physical distancing between others and myself.
- 4. To prevent the spread of COVID-19, I understand the importance of personal hygiene (not touching face, washing hands frequently, etc.)
- 5. I will avoid public spaces if I have symptoms of COVID-19 and contact Virginia Tech's Schiffert Health Center by telephone at 540-231-6444, my local health care provider, or an urgent care facility.
- 6. If directed to quarantine or isolate by a medical professional or university official, I will do so as long as deemed necessary.
- 7. I will inform Virginia Tech if I have a positive COVID-19 test or if I have experienced a direct contact situation with an individual with COVID-19.

I understand that failing to comply with these commitments can result in a referral to student conduct and/or termination of my housing contract.
